By 1890 architect John Calvin Stevens of Portland had achieved a national reputation for his work in the Shingle Style. This book explores the next four decades of his domestic architecture, an eclectic period in which he and his son John Howard Stevens designed houses ranging from Craftsman and Prairie School summer cottages to Colonial Revival mansions. Forty-seven of these distinctive homes are illustrated by 135 professionally taken period photographs. John Calvin Stevens II authored the biographical essay about his grandfather, and Earle G. Shettleworth, Jr. has provided a description of each house. In both illustrations and text, *John Calvin Stevens: Domestic Architecture, 1890-1930* presents new insights into the career of one of Maine's most talented architects.

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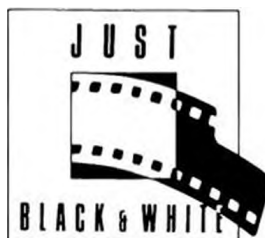


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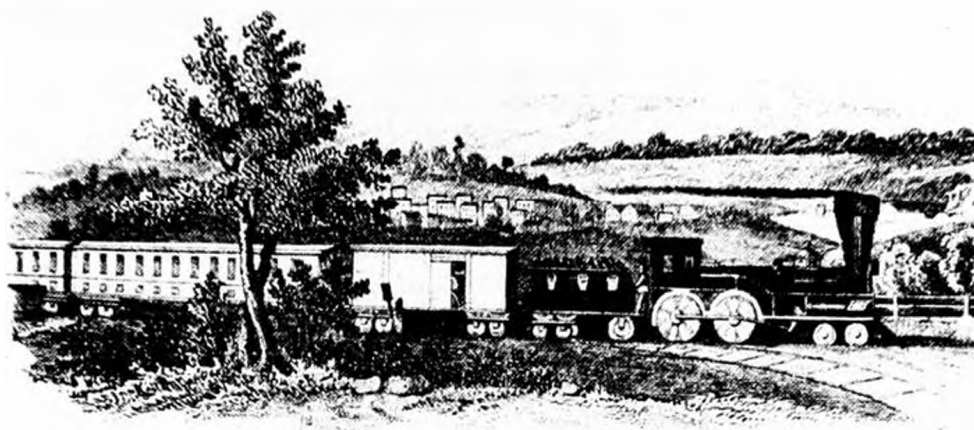
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
