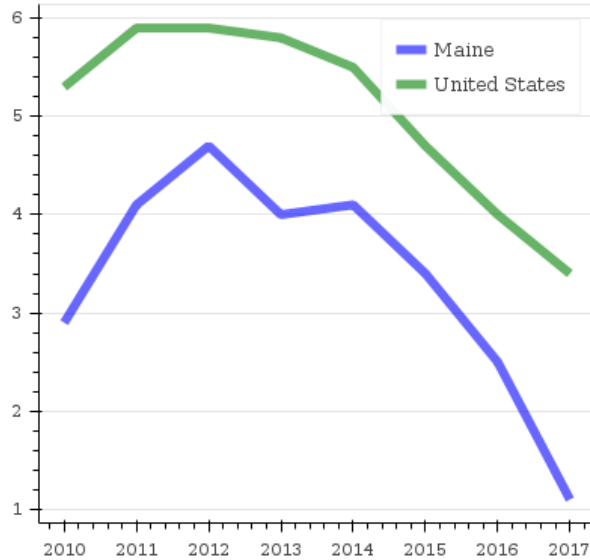


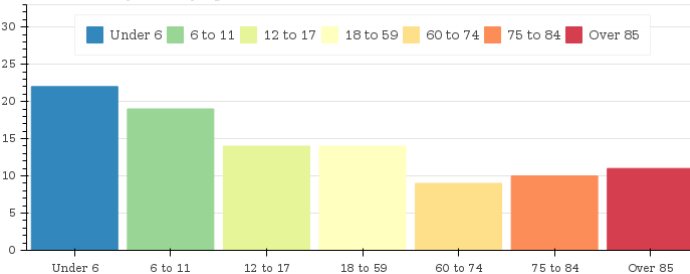
Facts About Poverty in Washington County

- Washington County is Maine's poorest county
- In 2018 Washington County's median income was \$41,3784 compared to Maine's median income of \$55,425
- The poverty rate for Washington County is 18.5% compared to Maine's poverty rate of 12.5%
- Maine's annual unemployment rate in 2019 was 3% compared to Washington county's annual unemployment rate of 4.6%

Maine Poverty Rate History

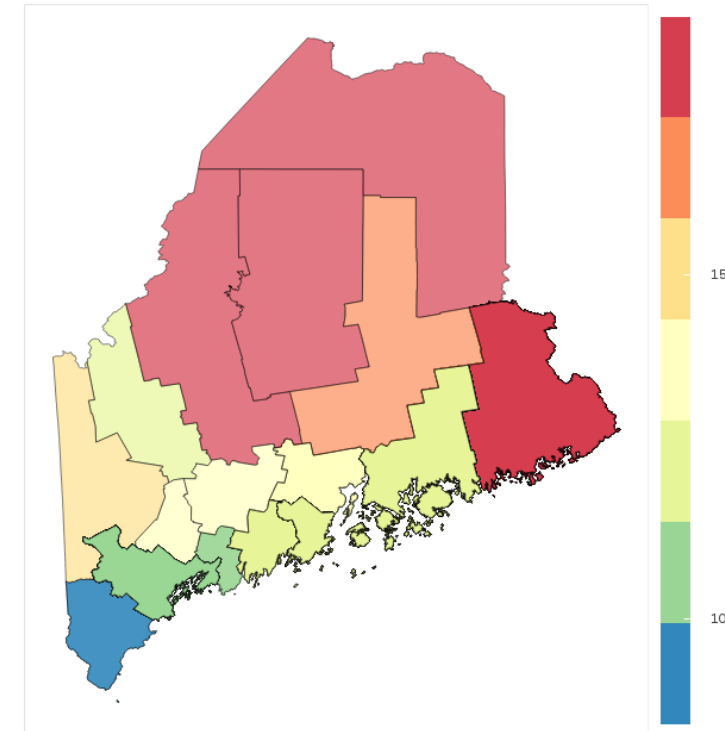


Maine Poverty Rate By Age

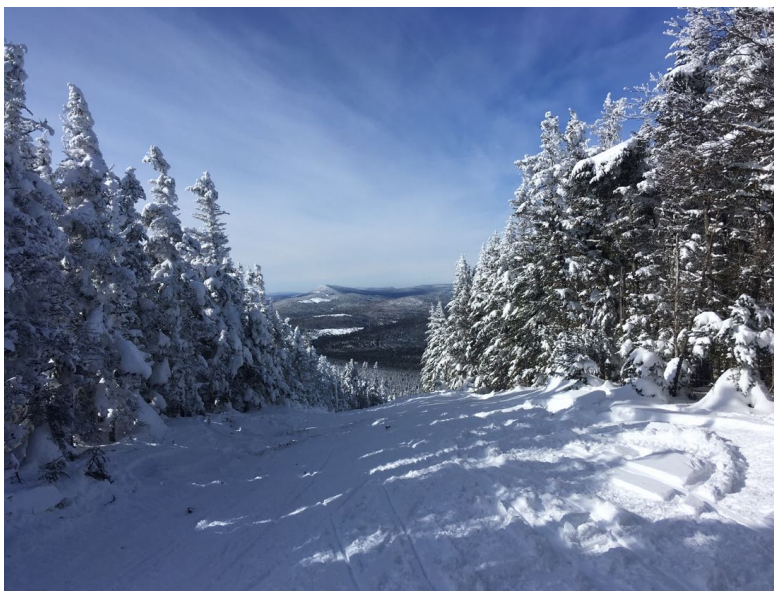
